

Maths:

In Maths we will begin to look at measure and pattern. We will start with comparing size and mass. We will be using the language of big, small, little, tall, long, short and large. If you would like to practise this at home with any toys they have or build towers with Lego, you could compare them and use the language above. We will be looking at heavy and light as well and introducing weighing scales with objects.
