## To the Parents of Year 2 (Woodpeckers) and Year 3 (Blue Whales)

Dear Parents and Carers,

Year 2, Woodpeckers and Year 3, Blue Whales will be taking their turn with Forest School. Woodpecker's class will have the afternoon session and Blue Whales class will have the morning session.

The first session will be on Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> January 2025 and will be every Tuesday until Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> February. The sessions will then resume after the half term break and will run from Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> February with the last session being on Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> April 2025.

The children will be learning with Humber Forest Schools in the school grounds on a Tuesday. We'll be using the outdoor classroom to extend our learning and enable the children to learn in a different environment.

Both classes will receive Forest School learning for the whole half term. We will keep you up to date with any changes. The children will require some old clothing and footwear that they don't mind getting dirty. They'll also need appropriate clothing for the weather. We'll be going out in all but the worst weather so they will need a waterproof coat and ideally trousers, if you have them. A change of footwear such as wellies for outside and trainers for inside would be ideal.

The children will be able to come to school in their old clothes on a Tuesday and won't need to wear uniform on that day.

We're really looking forward to making the most of our amazing grounds and reinforcing some of the learning in a different environment.
