Visit to Hornsea Museum and Hornsea Inshore Rescue, Hornsea

We are delighted to inform you that we have booked a visit for our Year 2 pupils to visit Hornsea Museum and Hornsea Inshore Rescue on Wednesday, 2nd July 2025.

This visit will link to our topic next term, Beside the Seaside. It will also link to our history study of Grace Darling. We feel this will also be a valuable opportunity to find out how our local coastal rescue operates.



We will be leaving school by coach at 9am and returning no later than

3.15pm. Our staff and our Woodpeckers Class will travel via coach from the Hornsea Museum to the Hornsea Inshore rescue. Pupils will need to wear their school uniform, including sensible shoes and a waterproof coat.

Under the universal free school meals scheme each child in our Woodpeckers class is entitled to a packed lunch provided by school. If you wish to provide your child with their packed lunch please ensure they have a healthy packed lunch and water bottle (no fizzy drinks please). Please note this must be nut free. Please could all children bring their filled water bottle.

To enable us to facilitate this visit, we would like to request a voluntary contribution of £23.40 from parents/carers. This cost includes coach travel, entry to the Hornsea Museum and entry to the Hornsea Inshore Rescue Centre. Please could payment be made via the Arbor app.
