Visit to Egyptian Museum and tour of East Riding Museum, Hull

We are delighted to inform you that we have arranged a visit for our Year 4 pupils to both The Egyptian Museum and a tour of the East Riding Museum on Wednesday 8th November.

This year, Y4 have been learning all about Ancient Egypt, their Pharaohs and way of life which will lend itself to the workshop and museum perfectly. At the workshop we will have the opportunity to explore an Egyptian gallery which is home to a 2600-year-old mummy and unique early replicas of King Tutankhamen's treasures.



We will be leaving school by coach at 9.00am and returning no later than normal finish time. Pupils will need to wear their school uniform
